

POSTER PREPARATION GUIDELINES

1. The suggested poster size is 72in wide(182.88cm) X 36in tall (91.44 cm) (Landscape Orientation). The poster boards are 8 ft wide (2.44 m) X 4ft tall (1.22 m).
2. Font and figures should be large enough to be clearly visible from a distance of approximately 1m (3ft 2in) or more.
3. At the top of each poster, you must clearly list the title, the names of the authors and their affiliations.
4. There are no other requirements or restrictions on specific layouts, scheme, font, colors, figures.
5. You may include QR codes linking to further data relating to your poster or to your researcher's page, on your poster.
6. Posters will need to be hanged on their assigned board in the Exhibitor Hall on Tuesday, November 10th between 8:30am – 4pm ET. We ask that you leave posters up throughout the conference.
7. The conference will feature three poster presentation sessions. While posters will remain on display throughout the conference, each presenter is assigned to one session and is expected to be present at their poster during that designated time. Presenters will be notified of their assigned session closer to the conference date.
8. Posters will need to be removed from the Exhibit Hall after the last poster session concludes. Any Posters that are NOT removed by Friday, November 13th 11:30am will be disposed.
9. We will provide pins to attach your posters to the boards.
